Moura State High School has completed a phase of restructuring to align our school with Middle and Senior phase of learning principles.

At Moura State High School, we are working towards the full implementation of the MPOL model and the requirements of the Queensland Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Framework (QCAR). 2008 is an implementation and transition year across the state for full practice in 2009.
